

Appendix to Positive Behaviour Policy

Coronavirus (COVID-19) has meant that children are returning to school with strict social distancing rules in place as well as increased hygiene expectations.

With this in mind children are expected to maintain these new rules/measures which school have put in place. As a school we completely understand that children may forget on occasion and 'slip ups' may take place. If this was the case then children would be reminded by staff of the rules.

However if a child/children deliberately break the rules regarding social distancing/health and hygiene rules then parents would be immediately informed and the situation would be discussed with them.

If it was felt that this had been a one off incident then we not take the matter further. However if school saw the incident as deliberate and with a high likelihood of it being repeated then we would unfortunately have to risk assess the child/children as being too dangerous to be allowed into school.

This would result in a formal exclusion until it was felt that the child would be able to reintegrate into school safely.
