



What will school be like if I return from 2nd June?

What is a 'bubble'?	The 'bubbles' will be groups of children and adults in school that spend the day together. To keep everyone safe, you will not spend any time with children or adults from a different bubble.			
Will I be with my friends?	Your class teachers will plan the bubbles very carefully and will let you know as soon as possible. You will spend the days in school with the other children and adults in your bubble.			If your friends are in this bubble, yes. There will be a mixture of children from all year groups in this bubble.
What time will I need to come to school?	9.15am	9.00am	8.45am	8.30am.
What will happen when I first get to my classroom?	You will wash your hands and sit on the carpet. Your teachers will show you where to sit.	You will wash your hands and go to your desk. The desks will be spaced out. You will have a name sticker on your desk and a pack of things you will need such as pens, pencils, whiteboard etc. This is only for you to touch.

What if I need the toilet?	You must remember to wash your hands properly.

What will happen at playtime time?	Playtime will be 10.30-10.45 and you will play on the grass at the front of the Reception Classroom. What will happen at lunchtime?	Before you come back to school, you will choose whether you will bring a pack up from home or whether you will have a grab-bag made by school. You will eat your packed lunch in your classroom with your bubble.

What lessons will I have?	In the morning, you will have maths, writing, reading and spelling activities, as well as some topic work. The activities will be the same as those planned for children learning at home.			In the morning, you will be working on your home-learning activities set by your class teacher.
	You will have lots of opportunities to play outside, keep active and do activities to help you settle back into school.			
Will there be assemblies?	No, not yet. We need to wait until we can all be together safely before assemblies start again.			
What time will I go home?	2.30pm	2.45pm	3.00pm	3.15pm
What if my brother or sister is in a different year group and start and finishes at a different time?	Both children will start at the earliest drop off time Both children will go home at the earliest pick up time			
Will there be any clubs?	No, not yet. We need to wait until we can all be together safely before clubs (including Breakfast and After School Club apart from those in the key worker group) start again			
What will I need to bring to school?	Your coat and your packed lunch (if you are bringing one from home) You do not need your bookbag, reading diary or anything else with you.			
What if I need new reading books?	You cannot take anything from school home with you. Your teachers have put lots of books on BugClub for you to read.			



Do I need to wear my uniform?	Only if you want to. You do not need to wear a uniform but please wear your trainers
What will happen on the days I am not in school?	You will be at home, continuing with your home learning tasks and spending time with your family.

Will I still need to do home learning tasks if I go to school?	Yes. The days you are at home, you still need to be learning.
How much work will I need to do at home?	Your teacher will continue to post challenges on Tapestry (EYFS), Class Dojo (Year 1) or on Google Classroom (year 6) This will help you keep up with your learning while you are at home.
Do I need to send work to my teacher?	Yes! We love seeing your work and how well you are all doing. Send as much as you can to your teacher. They will comment on what you have done so you know they have seen it.
How do I send work to my teacher?	Most of you already do send lots of work to your teacher. Continue doing this in the same way. Reception, upload your observations to Tapestry, Year 1 to Class Dojo and Year 6 continue to share your work on Google Classroom.
What if I don't do work one day?	That's ok. Try not to worry about work and try to have a better day tomorrow. Let someone know if you are finding your work hard. Also let someone know if you are worried about anything. It is important that you keep learning, ready for when we are all back in school together.
What if I want to do extra or if my brother or sister are working on a topic I am interested in?	It is important that you try to stick to your learning activities if you can, but any learning is better than none so go ahead and work on what is interesting to you!
What if I have problems using my device or my login won't work?	Please let your teacher know and they can try to help.
What if we don't have a printer at home and I need my work on paper?	If you need anything printing or new exercise books to work in, just let your teacher know and they will organise a time for you to safely come and collect it.
I am missing my teachers and my friends.	We are missing you all so much. Make sure you are keeping in touch with your friends and teachers via Tapestry, Class Dojo or Google Classroom. Check it daily for messages and videos from your teachers.
