Dear Parents/Carers,

We are constantly reviewing our capacity within school in order to ensure we are following government guidelines and offering places to those who have children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 as well as those who class as key workers or who may be considered vulnerable. With this in mind, we have contacted parents again this week and have been able to increase our numbers across all bubbles. This has been done in line with our risk assessments and government guidelines.

We now have the need for a second bubble of keyworker/vulnerable children and this will begin on Monday 22nd June. Any parents directly impacted by this have been contacted by school and they will receive separate information regarding arrangements for the new bubble. If you think you may need a place in a keyworker bubble then please could you contact school by **Wednesday 24th June** as we would like to finalise our groups until the end of term.

As part of our ongoing evaluation of procedures in school we have also been looking at home learning. You will receive a letter from your class teacher by the end of this week which revisits the home learning offered to particular year groups. Year 6 were sent out information last week so won't receive another letter. We are also looking at how we can offer more interaction/well being support to children in KS2 and teachers in KS2 are looking at how 'Google Meet' can be used to facilitate this.

Staff understand how difficult these times are for children who have not accessed school since March 20th and are constantly trying to engage and encourage children whilst supporting parents. We are always here to answer any questions and support in anyway we can.

Here at school we are very much thinking about September and what it may bring. Unfortunately we have no answers to this question currently but rest assured we are exploring all scenarios. Again I will do my best to answer any questions that you may have so please do not hesitate to contact school.

I would like to take this opportunity to say thank you for your continued support and patience as we work our way through this difficult time.
