



What will school be like in September 2020?

Will school be back to normal in September? I'm feeling a little bit nervous about coming back to school, is that OK?	Some children have been off school for quite a long time so it might feel strange at first coming back. All the adults who work at Badger Hill are looking forward to seeing you all and having everyone back so expect lots of big smiles and warm welcomes on your first day back! You may not have seen some of your friends for a long time, so it will be great to catch up! Your teachers have lots of nice 'back to school' activities planned so everything will feel back to normal very quickly! You will be back with friends from your class with your new class teacher. Most things will look and feel exactly the same but a couple of things have changed a little bit. Don't worry though as all the adults in school will talk you through everything on your first day. We will all be following the behaviour traffic light system, as we did before and giving out Dojo points to reward your super behaviour.

What time will I need to come to school?	Between 8.30 and 8.45am.				Between 8.45 and 9.00am.		
What will happen when I first get to school?	You will come in through your own classroom door. You will wash your hands and sit on the carpet. Your teachers will show you where to sit. You will have a pack of things (pencil, felt tips etc) with your name on it that will belong to you.		You will come in through the bottom playground gate and then walk to your classroom door.		You will come in through the top playground gate and go straight through the hall door and then into your classroom. 	You will wash your hands and go to your desk. The layout of the desks in your classroom might look slightly different. You will have a name sticker on your desk and a pack of things you will						



		<p>need such as pens, pencils, whiteboard, whiteboard pen, colouring pencils etc. This pack will be yours to use everyday when you are in school. You must look after the things in your pack and remember to put everything back in your pack when you have finished with it. It is important that we do not share things from our pack as these belong just to us.</p>		
What if I need the toilet?	<p>You will use the toilets in the reception classroom. Only two children can go to the toilet at one time.</p>	<p>You will use the open plan toilets next to the Year 2 and Year 3 classrooms. What will happen at playtime time?	<p>You will play with your friends in your bubble. KS1 will have fruit and milk as normal. Each 'bubble' will have a pack of playground equipment for you to play with whilst you are outside. You will all need to wash your hands before you go outside and when you come back into school.</p>

What will happen at lunchtime?	<p>As normal, before you come back to school, you will choose whether you will bring a pack up from home or whether you will have a lunch made by school. For the first three weeks lunches will be in the classroom apart from Reception and Y1 who will eat in the hall. You will be able to play with your pack of playtime equipment whilst you are playing outside.</p>			
	<p>You will have a play first on the main playground between 11.45-12.10 You will eat your lunch in the hall.</p>	<p>You will eat your lunch in your classroom between 12.15- 12.40 and then have a play outside from 12.45-1.10.</p>	<p>You will have a play first on the main playground between 12.15-12.35. What lessons will I have?	<p>Your day at school will be very similar to how it was last year. When you come in on a morning, you will have a spelling activity to do. You will then do your English, Maths and Guided Reading. In the afternoon, you will be working on our whole school topic 'The Great Yorkshire Show.' We will continue to do PE twice a week as well as all of our other subjects - DT, Music, Art, Geography, History, RE and PSHE. KS1 and KS2 will also have a Spanish lesson once a week with our new Spanish teacher Mrs Ruze. You will have lots of opportunities to play outside, keep active and do activities to help you settle back into school.</p>			
Will there be assemblies?	<p>No, not yet. We need to wait until we can all be together safely before assemblies start again. You will have class assemblies and Mrs Whittingham will continue to do the celebration assembly on a Friday but we will watch this on our whiteboard in our classrooms.</p>			



What time will I go home?	Between 3.00 and 3.10pm.	3.15pm	3.20pm	3.25pm.
What if my brother or sister is in a different year group and start and finishes at a different time?	Both children will start at the earliest drop off time. Parents will wait in the drop off/ pick up zone until siblings are sent out.			
Will there be any clubs?	Not straight away, but we are hoping that clubs will be able to start quite soon. We need to wait until we can all be together safely before clubs start again. Breakfast Club and After School Club will start on the 14th September.			
What will I need to bring to school?	Your coat, water bottle and your packed lunch (if you are bringing one from home) Your PE Kit and trainers, (to be brought on the first day and then to be left at school until half term) You need to make sure you bring your reading diary or KS2 planner everyday.			
What if I need new reading books?	You will also take home your colour banded book. If you are in year 2 upwards, you will be independently changing your book. You will continue to visit our school library once a week where you can choose a book to read at home. Your teacher will show you where the colour banded books are kept (as this will have changed). It is also really important that any books you bring back to school from home are kept in a 'Swap Box' for a couple of days before going back into the boxes or on the shelves. Don't worry though - your teachers will talk you through this so you know exactly what you need to do.			
Do I need to wear my uniform?	Yes, you will be wearing your school uniform as normal.			
Will I still be using Class Dojo or Google Classroom?	Your families now all have access to Class Dojo, which means they can send your teacher messages, they can see how many Dojos you get each day and your teacher can share all the brilliant stuff you are doing with your family. All KS2 children will access Google Classroom for homework, but this will be explained and demonstrated by your class teacher - so don't worry!
