



Remote learning in KS1

Below is a breakdown of how KS1 will continue to learn remotely via class dojo. Each day, children will have tasks to complete laid out in the weekly overview accompanied by teaching videos uploaded for each day.

This is our offer in KS1

Weekly overview	Each week Y1 and Y2 will receive an overview of the week. This will outline what we are learning this week, the tasks that are available and how we expect them to be completed. This document should act as a guide to help you navigate the different tasks and how to manage your time.
Video lessons	Both Y1 and Y2 will be providing videos for some lessons each day, for example phonics. This is done exactly how it would be in the classroom and so it is important that the children do watch these every day.
Activities	Y1 and Y2 will also be set a number of activities to complete over the week. In Y1, this will all be outlined in the google slides that Miss Meadows will share each day. In y2, these are all linked in the overview document for each subject. We understand that some people may not have printing facilities at home etc so we want you to know that how you submit these activities can be flexible. For example, class dojo is a great tool for sending photos and videos. Please get in touch with Miss Meadows or Miss Hart directly if you are struggling with this.
Story time	Every day, we will share the next part of our class book, just like we would do at school. Please make the time to enjoy this, it will be a lovely end to each day of home learning.
Google Meet	We will be offering a twice weekly Google Meet check in at the start and end of the week
