



Remote learning Year 3!

Below is a breakdown of how Year 3 will continue to learn remotely. Each day, children will have work released to them at 07:00 in the morning, to be completed by the end of the day.



This is our offer in Year 3

<p>Daily basic skills</p>	<p>In Year 3, we expect pupils to complete all of their shorter, basic skills tasks. This includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TT Rockstars – At least 10 minutes each day (50 minutes per week) • Spelling Shed – Weekly spelling activities and practice – New spellings released on a Friday afternoon, following Spelling Test in the morning • Reading - Children should read a text from home 5 times per week. This should still be recorded in their diary before being signed by an adult • Sumdog/Numbots - This is optional - children can practice their arithmetic skills here • Bug Club - This is to supplement reading, but isn't a task in itself. Children have lots of great texts that they can choose from here.
<p>Mathematics and English</p>	<p>Following the same medium term plan which had been created for Y3 in Spring Term, children will have their lessons adapted so they can follow the same objectives online. Mathematics and English (Writing and Reading) will be set in line with the class timetable, to reflect as much normality as possible.</p>
<p>Other curriculum</p>	<p>To further enhance our offer to Y3 students, we will also be asking them to engage with our topic for the half term which is the Stone Age. Tasks in subjects such as Science, History, Geography and Art will be linked to this theme. Over the course of this period of home learning, various tasks and projects will be set on Google Classroom.</p>
<p>Story time</p>	<p>At the end of each day, other than Friday, children will be able to watch a short video where Mr. Gibbons will read a class text.</p>
<p>Google Meet Registration</p>	<p>Each day Year 3 will meet between 9 and 10am to check in</p>
