



Remote learning Year 5!

Below is a breakdown of how Year 5 will continue to learn remotely. Each day, children will have work released to them at 08:30 in the morning, to be completed by the end of the day.

Weekly timetable uploaded onto Google Classroom	Each lesson on the timetable	Extra guidance and support uploaded alongside tasks	Teacher available to message through the Class Dojo app
Daily basic skills	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TT Rockstars – At least 10 minutes each day (50 minutes per week) • Spelling Shed – Weekly spelling activities and practice – New spellings released on Fridays with a Spelling Test on the Friday Google Meet. • Reading - Children should be reading at least 3 times per week. This should still be recorded in their diary before being signed by an adult. • Sumdog - This is optional - children can practice their arithmetic skills here • Bug Club – There are lots of great texts that they can choose from here. Let me know if they need more adding! 		
Mathematics and English	Following the same medium term plan which had been created for Y5 in Spring Term, children will have their lessons adapted so they can follow the same objectives online. Mathematics (including arithmetic) and English (Writing and Reading) will be set in line with the class timetable, to reflect as much normality as possible.		
Other curriculum	To further enhance our offer to Y5 students, we will also be asking them to engage with our topic for the half term which is South America . Tasks in subjects such as Science, History, Geography and Art will be linked to this theme. Over the course of this period of home learning, various tasks and projects will be set on Google Classroom – these may link to current news items or worries that the children may have.		
Story time	At the end of each day, other than Friday, children will be able to watch a short video where Mrs Waddle will read a class text. This will start with The Boy At The Back of The Class by Onjali Q. Raúf.		
Google Meet Registration	Each day Year 5 will meet around 10am to register and check in.		
PE	Children in Year 5 will be encouraged to take part in regular exercise as this is particularly important for wellbeing. Links to YouTube videos children (and families) can follow will be posted on Google Classroom.		

Catch up calls	Pupil catch up meetings
